6:10 OPENING SENTENCES (from Iona community)

One: Come to us this night, O God,

ALL: Come to us with light.

One: Speak to us this night, O God,

ALL: Speak to us in your truth.

One: Dwell with us this night, O God,

ALL: Dwell with us in love.

One: We gather here in your presence, God,

ALL: In our need, & bringing with us the needs of the world.

One: We come to you, for you come to us in Jesus,

ALL: And you know by experience what human life is like.

One: We come with our faith and with our doubts;

ALL: We come with our hopes and with our fears.

One: We come as we are, because you invite us to come;

ALL: And you have promised never to turn us away

Lift up your voices; the Lord is near. (2x)

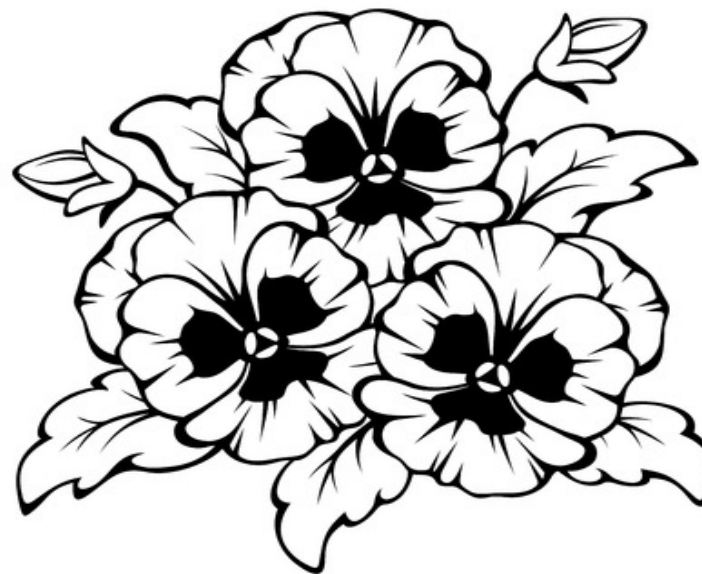
O CHRIST SURROUND ME (#543)
